Subject: Geneva: Chile Resolution

Martin Peblete flies to Geneva tomorrow, and Peter de Rhaze goes tonight. I asked Peter to be sure to bring Martin into close cooperation with our delegation.

I talked with George Jones in Santiago this afternoon. Our Embassy has not discussed our Chile Resolution "elements" paper with the Democratic Opposition. George said we will have to deal with Tabergs once again in Geneva. Santiago Embassy still has not seen the Mexican Resolution.

I called Peblete this afternoon. He had just learned that Tabergs will be going and was very disappointed (he had hoped for Jaime Castillo). He agreed with me that we should not let that discourage us, or prevent us from making a major effort, but he predicted that it will be very difficult to deal with the Mexican-Cuban-Tabergs combination. Peblete will do everything he can to help us help Chilean democracy.
