Bill:

I believe it would be desirable to tell Don that you have seen the two attached documents: the Human Rights in Chile hearings, just published, and the Human Rights in the World Community report, put out by Don's Subcommittee in March.

On the Human Rights in Chile hearings, I recommend noting the first page list of Committee and Subcommittee members, the list of witnesses, and the meeting with Harry Shlaudeman (pps. 109-138) If you do not have time for that much, please note the marked portion of page 110 (paper clipped) and at least scan pps. 122-137.

In the Human Rights in the World Community report I recommend reading the short preface (paper clipped) plus pps. 1 through 8. You will note that some of the Subcommittee's 29 recommendations have already been implemented. For example, with reference to recommendation 5, each of the five Regional Bureaus has a Human Rights Officer. As you know, I am the ARA representative. I work closely with the Assistant Legal Adviser for Human Rights (L/HR), Charles Runyon, an excellent man who is doing a first class job. Most of the drafting of the Human Rights in the World Community report was done by John Salzberg, a good chap who works for Don and who will be present at today's meeting.
