# Proclamation

**WE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO AND THE COUNTY OF WEBB** will not tolerate domestic violence in our community;

**WE RECOGNIZE** that domestic violence is destructive for victims, their families and our community;

**WE RECOGNIZE** that victims of domestic violence experience physical abuse, long term emotional harm, financial instability, homelessness, and chronic fear;

**WE HAVE COME TOGETHER** with open hearts and minds to support victims of domestic violence in our community for over twenty years;

**WE RECOGNIZE** our police and sheriff's departments, courts, city, county, social service agencies, and other local governmental entities constitute the first line of defense to protect and serve victims of domestic violence; and

**WE BELIEVE** that in working together, we can protect and empower all domestic violence victims;

**WE REMAIN DETERMINED** to move forward in our mission to stop domestic violence,

**NOW THEREFORE, WE RESOLVE**, that the City of Laredo and the County of Webb in the State of Texas join national and world leaders, including the Inter-Commission on Human Rights to declare **FREEDOM FROM DOMESTIC VIOLENCE A FUNDAMENTAL HUMAN RIGHT**.

**WE FURTHER RESOLVE** that the City of Laredo and County of Webb will work relentlessly to secure and protect this fundamental human right on behalf of all our citizens,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Tano Tijerina as County Judge of County of Webb and I, Juan Narvaez, Mayor Pro-Tempore of the City of Laredo do hereby proclaim on behalf of our citizens the month of October 2015 as **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH**.

**WE CALL OUR CITIZENS TO ACTION:**

First, to continuously educate ourselves about domestic violence by participating in trainings, coalition meetings, community outreach and activities to empower each other to speak and act out against domestic violence and/or to serve as advocates for the victims, families and perpetrators.

Second, to collect, maintain, and report data to the Webb County Domestic Violence Coalition on how we serve victims of domestic violence.

Third, to convene each year after our annual conference to create a concrete plan of action to better serve victims of domestic violence and to monitor progress at our monthly coalition meetings
