REGISTRATION for ALL CONTINUING & READMITTED STUDENTS & ADD/DROP

Monday, April 17	8:00 AM – 12 Midnight

REGISTRATION & ADD/DROP FOR ALL STUDENTS.

Friday-Sunday, August 25-August 27	8:00 AM – 12 Midnight
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LATE REGISTRATION for all students not yet registered (*students registering for the first time will be assessed a \$25 late fee*). ADD/DROP for students previously registered (no \$25 fee).

Monday, August 28	8:00 AM – 12 Midnight
Tuesday, August 29	8:00 AM – 5:00 PM
Wednesday-Thursday, August 30-September 1	8:00 AM – 12 Midnight
Tuesday, September 5	8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Registration and adds/drops after September 5 must be completed through the Texas Law Student Affairs Office, TNH 2.116, 8 AM-5 PM. *Students registering September 6-September 15 will be assessed a \$50 late fee. Students who are permitted to register after September 15 will be assessed a \$200 late fee.*

Wednesday-Thursday, September 6-September 14	8:00 AM – 12:00 Midnight
Friday, September 15	8:00 AM – 5:00 PM

Students who register April 17-September 5 must pay tuition by 5 PM, September 5. Students who are registered and paid but add/drop courses August 25 –September 15 must pay add bills by 5 PM, September 15.

To pay your tuition bill online, go to “My Tuition Bill” at https://utdirect.utexas.edu/acct/fb/my_tuition/my_tuition_home.WBX. To pay in person, go to the cashiers in the Main Building, Room 8, 8:30 AM-4:30 PM. Payment must be received by 5 PM on the due day. Refunds will be mailed 1 week after the University’s official 12th class day.

Even if your tuition is zero, you must still confirm your attendance before the payment deadline. Nothing is automatic. Whether you are paying directly, via financial aid, or via a third party (grants, scholarships, Texas Guaranteed Tuition Plan, etc.), you must indicate that you will attend and/or arrange for payment. You must do this via the “My Tuition Bill” link by the payment deadline or risk cancellation of your course(s).
