
# LET'S TALK ABOUT ZOOM

- For your classes, make sure audio and video are on. Yes, video.
  - But always enter the room on mute.
- Make sure you're muted unless called on.
- All of your classes are being recorded and will be made available.
- Side by side mode
  - You can make the person speaking and whatever they're sharing equal in size. Go to view options at the top of the screen and select side by side. You can try it today.

  - Directed Research & Study or Adv. Clinic
  - Non-Law courses
  - Application Classes

# ADDITIONAL NOTES

- We cannot guarantee you will get specific courses. Due to priority and enrollment limits, the class(es) you request may be full.
- We recommend you do not list the same class several times. For example, do not request 3 sections of Negotiation for your top 3.
- You must remain bar-free through April 17th, or you will lose your awarded classes. You will receive an email if you need to clear a bar or bars.
- Any changes to the course schedule will be posted on the SAO home page under “Recent Updates.”
- To register or change your schedule after early registration (add/drop) use the Registrar’s online system. The first access period for ROSE is April 20<sup>th</sup> – May 1<sup>st</sup>. Specific access times will be available on the Student Affairs website.
