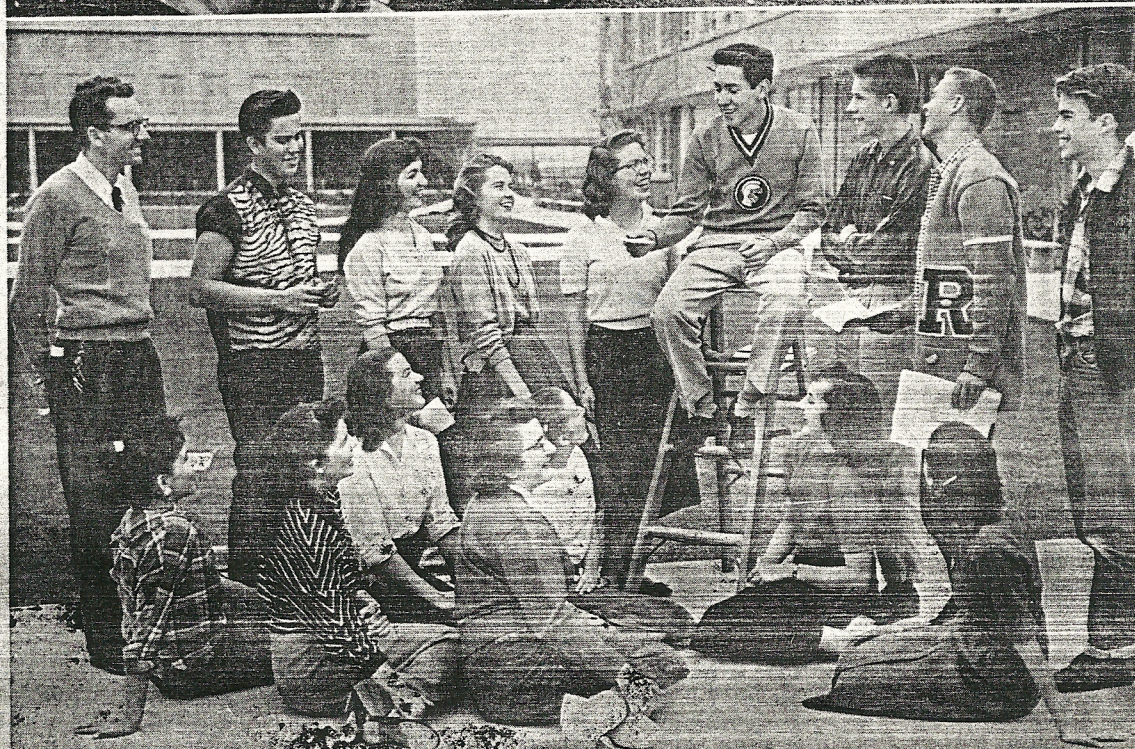
PRE ENGINEERS
