### **Diversity in the Profession Committee History**

The Diversity in the Profession Committee is one of twenty-eight committees of the State Bar of Texas. In 1989, then State Bar President Darrell Jordan of Dallas created the Committee, formerly known as the Opportunities for Minorities in the Profession Committee. Its purpose was to increase diversity in the profession, enhance opportunities for diverse individuals in the profession, and increase involvement by diverse attorneys in the bar. Just one year after its inception, the State Bar institutionalized the Committee as a standing committee, and its members successfully worked with the State Bar Board of Directors to initiate an ethnicity survey of bar membership, create a permanent staff position dedicated exclusively to minority affairs, and approve the support for diversity in State Bar grievance committees. The Committee later adopted its current name, the Diversity in the Profession Committee, to reflect the changing demographics of the state of Texas. Not lost, though, was the Committee's continual focus on promoting and pursuing new prospects and opportunities for all diverse attorneys, including women.

#### **Diversity in the Profession Committee Composition**

The Diversity in the Profession Committee is composed of twenty-eight accomplished attorneys appointed by the President-Elect of the State Bar of Texas. Committee members serve a three-year term on a volunteer basis.

#### **Scholarship Objectives**

The Diversity in the Profession Committee aims to strengthen and diversify the pipeline of individuals entering the legal profession and encourage involvement in the State Bar of Texas by familiarizing students with State Bar activities. By helping defray the financial burden of preparing for the Texas Bar Exam, this scholarship facilitates the transition into the legal profession for law students from backgrounds traditionally under-represented in the profession. This year, the scholarships will be awarded either in the form of cash awards (stipends) and/or credit toward bar prep course costs.

#### Eligibility and Scholarship Criteria

Third-year law school students, or graduates within the past 12 months, of an ABA-accredited law school, and who are preparing for the 2023 Texas Bar Exam are eligible for this scholarship. Selection criteria include but are not limited to academic achievement, financial need, involvement in community/extracurricular activities including student organizations and affinity groups, and leadership experience.
