Application Deadline: December 31, 2025

Criteria & Eligibility: Eligibility is limited to first-year and second-year law school students currently enrolled (in good standing) in Texas law schools. Factors considered in making the award include:

- Demonstrated interest, background or experience in local government law
 - Shown either by the applicant's internships, clerkships, work experience, coursework, volunteer history, publications, etc.
- Ties or a connection to Texas.
- 300-350 word Statement of Interest on how municipal law or local government has impacted the applicant's life, or professional contributions the applicant seeks to make to the field.
- 2 Reference Letters from local government lawyers or law professors confirming the applicant's interest and promise in the area of local government law.
- Resume outlining education, experience, honors, and professional interests.
- Law School Transcript (unofficial is acceptable).
- 2-3 minute video (*Optional* – Applicant can state or show they desire to be a municipal lawyer or how they have demonstrated that interest in local government law.)
- The Scholarship will be awarded based primarily on the merits of the written submissions, and evaluation of the supporting references.
- An applicant's financial need may also be considered. Applicants must submit a brief statement disclosing all other scholarships and grants they will be receiving for the relevant (current or upcoming) school year.
