#### When and where?

#### Who will you meet?

We expect a wide range of students, law clerks, postgraduates, doctoral candidates and young professionals with a strong interest in studying law in the United States.

#### How can I present my law school?

Your university will be assigned to a custom-designed booth where you can meet with students and display materials and schedule private meetings.



#### What is the fee?

A law school registering will pay an attendance fee of EUR 3,000. If you *book before May 31, 2019*, you will receive a discount of EUR 500.

#### What is the deadline to apply?

Participation is limited to 16 law schools per fair. Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Please apply before September 20.

The nearest airport with frequent direct flights to and from the U.S. is Düsseldorf, which is 45 minutes from Cologne by train or car. The Cologne/Bonn and Frankfurt airports provide excellent connections as well. It takes 20 minutes from Cologne/Bonn airport into the city and 60 minutes from Frankfurt to Cologne by train.


